Budget Discussion Topics:

Health Insurance: Melissa Harvey, Director of Finance for Schools delivered a presentation on Health Insurance Coverage for Surry County Employees outlining current plans, potential adjustments and recommendations for the coming year.

As acceptance is required by April 1, Ms. Rollins requested consensus from the Board to recommend Option 1: Sunset the Key Advantage Expanded plan and transition all current enrollees to the Key Advantage 250 plan. All members were in favor and thanks Ms. Harvey for her presentation of options.

Budget Drivers: Melissa Rollins, County Administrator updated the Board on the impact of public service corporation tax revenue valuations and projected revenue for FY 26 and the projected for FY 27 noting the significant decrease in revenue and the impact it will have on meeting the budget needs of the County to include requests received by all departments, the school division for personnel needs to right size teacher steps and operating budget needs countywide.

Shared Financial Services: Delon Brown, Deputy County Administrator of Operations & Infrastructure led a discussion on the benefits of shared financial services between the County and the School System, emphasizing opportunities for collaboration and cost efficiency.
