### **Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order at 6:08 pm by Chairman Pierce

### **Consent Items**

1. Consideration for Personal Property Tax Deadline Extension

Chairman Pierce mentioned that the consent item for the Board of Supervisors action was to the proposed resolution to extend the personal property tax due date deadline from June 5<sup>th</sup> to June 15<sup>th</sup>.

Supervisor Seward inquired as to the fiscal year associated with the June Billing.

County Administrator Rollins responded that the rates set are for Tax Year 2026. Supervisor Seward asked if discussion had taken place regarding alleviating action in the future.

County Administrator Rollins responded affirmative, stating that such communication in the future would need to begin with the Commissioner of the Revenue responsible for preparing the tax books and the Treasurer, who is responsible for getting the bills out to the taxpayer. Operational challenges resulting from the first year of implementation to June 5<sup>th</sup> without extending the due date was presented as this year's issue.

Supervisor Hardy stated that the legal requirements were met by the Treasurer in that the bills were mailed within 14 days.

Supervisor Drew asked if the County could look into what would be required if the county could make it a 30-day window in the future.

Mrs. Rollins read the resolution.

Chairman Pierce asked for a motion on the resolution.

Supervisor Hardy made a motion to approve the resolution as presented. Supervisor Seward seconded.

All voted in favor.

### **Adjournment**

Chairman Pierce asked for a motion for adjournment to June 4, 2026.

Supervisor Hardy moved, and Supervisor Elliott seconded.
